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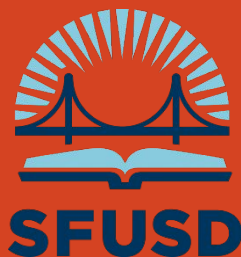

## WHAT TPP OFFERS

Job Exploration Counseling-discover career interests.

Work Based Learning Experiences-gain valuable experience while learning on the job.

Counseling on Post Secondary Opportunities-connections to work sites and community partners in San Francisco.

Job Coaching-job orientation, on-site support, and job placement.

Work Readiness-resume writing, interview skills, application preparation, and instruction on self-advocacy.

## WHAT IS TPP

Our Transition Partnership Program (TPP) is a pre-employment program for at least 40 students per year. Students can be sophomore, juniors, seniors, or students who are exiting the district.

TPP provides work readiness skills, job development, placement, and Department of Rehabilitation support.

\*The Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) is Federal program for individuals with disabilities who want to work. DOR assists students with meaningful employment after they graduate.

Earn valuable on the job experience.

Make connections with important community partners in San Francisco.

Leave our program with work readiness techniques including interviewing skills, application and resume writing talent, and the ability to self-advocate.
